

ΦΣΣ Dues 2023-2024

Out of house sister dues are \$763, which includes:

- All national fees
- Sisterhood activities
 - Sisterhood retreats
 - Sisterhood events like outings and retreats, events at the house and more!
- Social Events
 - Date Nights
 - 100 Most Wanted Party
 - Formal
 - Mixers
- T-shirts for Back to School, Homecoming, Recruitment, Bid Day, Dance Marathon and more
- Family events like Parents Day Tailgate and Parents Brunch

In house sisters pay \$588 (\$175 less) and the cost to live in the house equals the cost of living in the dorms.

Out of house sister meal plan is \$870, which includes:

- 5 meals per week at the house plus special events.
- Our staff includes 3 chefs, dishwashers, and a full-time housekeeper.
- Lunch is cooked to order Monday – Friday and includes a salad bar, soup and sandwich specials.
- Dinner is served Sunday – Thursday and includes a salad bar and 2 entrees.
- Our chefs take great care of us and accommodate all dietary issues. They treat us like we are their own daughters, and we love them!

If you are living in the dorms, you have a minimum meal plan requirement through RU. For example:

\$2,939 (210 meals, Freshman)	\$2,777 (150 meals, Sophomore)
<u>\$1,366 (Drop to 75 meal plan)</u>	<u>\$1,366 (Drop to 75 meal plan)</u>
\$1,573 – REFUND CHECK FROM RU	\$1,411 – REFUND CHECK FROM RU

You can use your refund check to pay for your meal plan and even part of your dues!

Payment Plans Make It Easier

- Many sisters pay dues and the meal plan in up to 5 payments each semester.
- Sisters receiving financial aid can pay their dues and meal plan after they receive their refund check.

ΦΣΣ New Member dues are \$960, which includes:

- \$386 paid to Phi Sigma Sigma National
 - New member fee, new member pin
 - Initiation fee
 - Jeweled Sisterhood Badge
- \$574 balance is paid in two payments of \$287
 - Covers all chapter activities

The meal plan is optional the semester you join, but if you decide to take the meal plan right after recruitment, we can reduce your Rutgers meal plan and get you a refund to cover the cost of eating at the house. Depending on your current meal plan, your total refund would be between \$1,572 and \$1,411.
